GOLDSPEED EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP

The first ever GP Quad in St Mamet France was held on a beautiful track with 90% overview. On a cloudy but warm Saturday local hero Couprie won the qualification with 4 seconds before Holmes and Brems.

On Sunday the sun was there with in the afternoon a temperature above 30°. We had beautiful races with tree man fighting each other. As he showed us on Saturday Couprie was the best of the field and won the three heats. Montalbini was second in the 1st and 3th heat and second in the second heat.

Holmes came back from 15 position to 3th in the 1st heat and finished 2de in the 2de heat after a nice fight with Couprie. In the 3th heat Holmes' bike stopped on the starting gate. He couldn't go on. The third position in this heat was taken by another English rider Macbeth.

The overall was for the French local hero Couprie who won this home-GP, followed by Montalbini and MacBeth.

The next round of the Championship will be held the 8th of August in Kegums (Latvia).
