### NEW SUPERMOTO RULES

*The Supermoto Commission, which met in Porto (Portugal) during the UEM Congress, decided the following:*

- 1. Change of articles 042.18 / 042.20 / 042.21.1 (European Championship Rulebook) regarding the maximum number of riders allowed to participate in an European Championship race. In some exceptional circumstances in cases of combined races (2 classes racing together) and upon the approval of the UEM Representative and the UEM Race Director, more than 32 riders can be allowed on the starting grid. The additional riders should be only from the younger class.*
- 2. Change of article 042.10.2.3 regarding tyres. For each UEM Supermoto European Championship event each rider may use a maximum total quantity of eight tyres (instead of six).*
- 3. Change of article 042.2.2 (European Championship Rulebook) / 043.2.2 (European Cup Rulebook) regarding Age of Riders:*
  - a. for S Open class minimum age from 16 to 15 years of age*
  - b. for S 3 class minimum age from 15 to 14 years of age.*
