



Videos of the 2009 Superstock 600 season are now available on line

The Superstock 600 European Championship highlights are now available on line in the video section.

This is a Championship for stock motorbikes with an engine of 600 cc., where practically no modification is allowed, which is considered a major source of future champions. Here the most talented young European riders cut their teeth racing against one another on the same racetracks where the Supersport and Superbike World Championship races take place.

In 2009 the European title of this category went to the London rider Gino Rea. The twenty-year-old rider of the Ten Kate Honda Racing Team, who achieved one victory, three second places and two third places, won the Championship only at the end of the last round in Portimao. His best opponents, who fought for the European crown until the finish line of the Portuguese race, were the Italian riders Marco Bussolotti and Danilo Petrucci (Yamaha Italia Junior Trasimeno, who finished second and fourth respectively) and the Belgian Vincent Lonbois who finished third in the rider standings.

The Italian rider Eddi La Marra (Honda) and the French riders Jeremy Guarnoni (Yamaha) and Florian Marino (Honda) were also among the absolute protagonists of the last season. Besides, the fact that the Superstock champion Gino Rea will take part in the next Supersport World Championship season, with a Honda CBR 600 RR of the Intermoto Czech Team, is a further confirmation of the first-class level of the Superstock 600 Championship.
