### TRIAL EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP IN FOPPOLO

*Italian Daniele Maurino (Gas Gas) and Spanish Pol Tarres (Gas Gas) topped the podium in the fifth European Trial Championship round, held in Foppolo, near Bergamo, North of Italy, on the eve of the World Championship.*

*Having rained a lot during the evening of the day before, organizers opted for simplifying the sections. A wonderful shining day helps to improve the grip on all the obstacles, consequently the competition become quite easy for everybody.*

*Between the fighters for the championship in the top class, only British Alexz Wigg (Beta) took an advantage. Thanks to his third place, he gained the leadership in the overall standings, shared with the previous leader, Matteo Grattarola (Sherco) today only in sixth position, one place behind the other rival for high positions in this championship, British Jack Challoner.*

*Maurino confirmed his great moment: after being the best Italian rider the week before in the World Championship disputed in San Maurizio, he rode this trial keeping his cool in each section. He only fived section three in the first lap and that was all. Then he gathered 27 cleans in a row! Second place for Spanish Francesc Moret (Montesa) who scored 6 points in total and cleaned all the second lap, as Maurino did. Wigg came in third, but was leading at the turning points having been the only one to clean the first loop, when sections resulted still not completely dried.*

*In the Junior class, Tarres built his win thanks to a precise first lap, ended with only 3 marks lost, against the 8 scored by his rival, British Jack Sheppard, Beta, who recovered very well cleaning the whole second lap, but Tarres dabbed once and got his third win in a row, that means to overtake Sheppard in the overall standings. Tarres is now leading one point ahead of Sheppard. Third today and firmly third in the championship Italian Giacomo Saleri (Beta) who scored one point less than on other Italian rider, Ismael Catalin (Gas Gas).*

*In the Over40 class, only Polish Krzysztof Paluch (Gas Gas) entered and won!*
